

## GOULBURN VALLEY WATER DESIGN GUIDELINES

### Introduction

The Goulburn Valley Water Design Guidelines are intended to provide information on the design practices and principles for the design and construction of GVW facilities.

The facilities included in the guidelines include minor and major installations that are required on occasions to be constructed for development projects, such as a water supply booster pump station and storage tank. They are assets that are not included in the product manual.

The aim is to provide guidelines for consultants and developers that will result in an asset that is consistent with the Corporation's standards and will be accepted with minimal modification at preliminary acceptance. This will also avoid different equipment, qualities of construction, maintenance requirements and site layouts being provided for similar assets within Goulburn Valley Water's region.

The adoption of these guidelines will also provide the developer and their consultant with a clear understanding of the Corporation's requirements at the project inception stage. This will enable accurate costing of the works, consultation with stakeholders and approvals to be gained prior to works commencing.

The design guidelines included in this section of the Development and Construction Manual are a selection from Goulburn Valley Water's Design Manual, which is an internal document that provides a single source of design information for GVW facilities.

### Design Guidelines

The design Guidelines that are included in this document are:

- Building Aesthetics
- Water Supply Booster Pump Station (Pumping to Storage Tank)
- Water Reticulation Storage Tank (Ground)

Goulburn Valley Water aims to continually upgrade and revise these documents and include new guidelines as required.
