

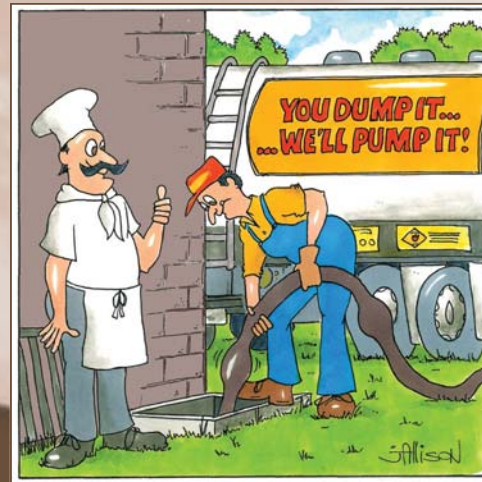
# Fat facts about your business



Grease traps prevent your fats, oils and solids from getting to the sewer.

**Size does matter!** Grease traps need to be sized properly and installed correctly.

**Pump it!** You need to have your grease trap pumped out regularly by an EPA-licensed contractor.



**Greasy waste is liquid waste containing fats, oils and grease**

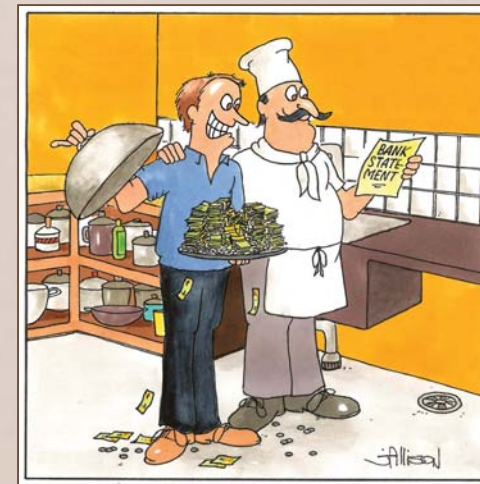
To reduce greasy waste, protect the environment AND save money, try the following:

- ✓ Wipe before washing.
- ✓ Use less cooking oil where you can.
- ✓ Pour used oil into containers for recycling.
- ✓ Sweep floors before washing or hosing.
- ✓ Collect food scraps for composting.
- ✓ Use less detergent.
- ✗ **No oil down the drain.**

Greasy waste can cause blockages in sewers. And this is what could happen:



By reducing greasy waste you can save on detergent, grease trap pump-outs, and use less water.



And it helps protect our precious waterways.
